

Empowering Girls Secondary Education



ABOUT PROJECT

The project reaches a total number of 100 girls including girls living with disabilities in the targeted communities in Eastern Province. Below is a description of the three categories of the direct beneficiaries;

GIRLS WHO DO NOT HAVE ACCESS TO A SECONDARY SCHOOL.

These are girls of school going age for the targeted grades who are not enrolled in school due to various barriers such as long distances to school or limited school space.

GIRLS WHO HAVE ACCESS TO SECONDARY SCHOOL BUT WHO ARE NOT ENROLLED.

These are children who have access to school but are not enrolled in school due to stigma and lack of assistive devices for those with disabilities, lack of support due to poverty, lack of appreciation for the value of education, negative cultural practices and over age. The project will also indirectly benefit OOSC who have access to a school but dropped out of school.

GIRLS WHO HAVE DROPPED OUT OF THE EDUCATION SYSTEM.

These are girls who were enrolled in secondary school (8th Grade) but have left school due various reasons such as early marriages, teenage pregnancy, lack of interest in school, unsupportive learning environment, lack of support due to poverty, lack of appreciation for the value of education, negative cultural practices, over age and health conditions
